Preparation for upcoming Khelo India University Games 2020:

NADA officials were deputed to visit Bhubaneswar on 19-20 December, 2019 to see the provision of doping control and existing facilities at various stadiums venue for the upcoming Khelo India University Games 2020 to be held from Feb 22- March 01, 2020. NADA officials interacted with the officials of the Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) which is the major venue for the event and discussed about the anti doping requirements for smooth implementation of dope control program during the games. Meeting was also held with the Director of the Capital Govt. Hospital, Bhubaneswar with regard to the empanelment of DCOs/BCOs/ Chaperones required during the University Games.

Training for newly empanelled Doping Control Officers:

Two days training program for newly empanelled DCOs and BCOs from Government Medical College, Guwahati was organized by NADA from 12-13 December 2019 at Guwahati. A total 26 nos. of DCOs/BCOs were duly briefed about the doping control program run by NADA and were imparted training as per WADA guidelines for sample collection procedure. Services of these newly empanelled DCOs/BCOs will be utilized during KIYG 2020, Guwahati.
