Training for newly empanelled Doping Control Officers (DCOs):

Two days training program for newly empanelled DCOs and BCOs from Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar was organized by NADA from 11-12 February 2020 at Bhubaneswar. A total 31 nos. of DCOs/BCOs were duly briefed about the doping control test procedure by deputed NADA official and have been imparted training as per WADA guidelines for sample collection procedure.

Dope Control Program during Khelo India University Games 2020, Orissa

To ensure fair play in sports and create awareness amongst the youth participants, NADA has organized Dope Control Program i.e. Sample Collection, Awareness Program for athletes during the Khelo India University Games 2020 held at Bhubaneswar from 22 Feb.-01 Mar. 2020.

A total of 179 dope samples including 22 blood samples have been collected during the games in all the disciplines. The services of newly empanelled trained DCOs/BCOs of Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar were also used for sample collection work. Anti-Doping Awareness Program for participant sportspersons was conducted from 21-26 Feb. 20 during the games in which 885 players were imparted anti doping education by NADA.
